Dear Candidates,

Kindly note the following regarding the IGCSE/AS/A-Level examinations, commencing from Wednesday, April 21, 2021

1. Examinations which are indicated as ‘AM’ on the Statement of Entry will begin at **08:30 am** in the morning and the examinations which are indicated as ‘PM’ on the Statement of Entry begin as per the given timings in the schedule for afternoon session.
2. Candidates **MUST** report at the Examination Centre (**Al Ansar International School**) at **08:00 am** for the morning sessions and **30 minutes** prior to the scheduled time for the afternoon sessions.
3. Candidates will be granted entry into the Examination Hall, **ONLY** if they are in **proper school uniform** (completed PE uniform is acceptable) **and in possession of their Statement of Entry**.
4. Candidates must produce their **Emirates ID** in order to sit for the Examination.
5. Exchange of any kind of stationery, in the examination hall, is **strictly prohibited**. Please bring with you pens, pencils, erasers, **calculators (NON-PROGRAMMING)**, etc. which you may require for a particular examination. (*Calculators are NOT allowed for Computer Science Exams*).
6. **Mobile Phones** or any other means of communication will not be allowed inside the Examination Hall. (**Kindly note that if found in your possession, such items will be confiscated.**)
7. Communication with other candidates is prohibited, once you enter the Examination Hall. Anyone found **misbehaving** or **causing any kind of disturbance or distraction** in the examination hall will be **debarred** from the examination.
8. On the day of an examination, once you reach the centre, **DO NOT** wander around; instead, remain seated in the waiting area and keep revising until your invigilators escort you to the Examination Hall.
9. Candidates should arrange their **own transport** for the examinations. They should reach the venue 30 minutes before the scheduled time and must leave the venue immediately after the conclusion of their session.
